A dinner paired with wines from Cornish vineyard Camel Valley should not be missed, while King of Carnivores, Richard Turner (Hawksmoor, Meatopia, Plant Life, Black Lock) takes over the restaurant for a very special dinner this summer.

Nathan will celebrate six years in Knightsbridge by serving his most renowned dishes paired with Henriot Champagne, while in July, guests will have the chance to vote for their favourite dishes to appear on the menu.

Nathan Outlaw, arguably Britain's finest seafood Chef, holds 4 Michelin stars, including Restaurant of the Year 2018, Restaurant Nathan Outlaw. Known for his simple and honest approach to seafood cookery, his Knightsbridge outpost, at 5-star The Capital Hotel, brings a flavor of Cornwall to London, as his team, lead by Head Chef, Andrew Sawyer, champion the best of seasonal and sustainable British seafood. Nathan and the team work closely with the Cornish fishermen, who land fresh fish and shellfish daily using low impact fishing methods that preserve the marine environment, to dictate their ever-changing menus.
